FADE IN:

INT. REICH CHANCELLERY — DAY

SUPER: "SEPTEMBER 1, 1939. BERLIN, GERMANY."

THREE GERMAN GENERALS, LEONHARD KAUPISCH, NIKOLAUS VON FALKENHORST, AND HANS GRAF VON SPONECK enter the office to inform THE FUHRER, ADOLF HITLER, about the aftermath of the Nazi Invasion of Poland.

LEONHARD KAUPISCH

[speaking in German] *My Fuhrer, we secured Poland.*

NIKOLAUS VON FALKENHORST

[speaking in German] *Also, we have learned the English entered France again.*

ADOLF HITLER

[speaking in German] *Then why are the English return to France?*

LEONHARD KAUPISCH

[speaking in German] *Because we've lost the battle at France years ago, my Fuhrer.*

NIKOLAUS VON FALKENHORST

[speaking in German] *And not only that, but they also allied with the French just like they did last time.*

HANS GRAF VON SPONECK

[speaking in German] *I agree with Nikolaus. We have an alternate plan to conquer France.*

ADOLF HITLER

[speaking in German] *What's your alternate plan to take Paris, Hans?*

LEONHARD KAUPISCH

[speaking in German] *Since our peace treaty was signed in the last war, we recommended to reverse the situation against them by using our advanced weapons to crush the Allies in Europe.*

ADOLF HITLER

[speaking in German] *Then send the Waffen SS to split up. I'll send COMMANDER FEDOR VON BOCK to finish what we started in the last war.*

NIKOLAUS VON FALKENHORST

[speaking in German] *You're insane!*

LEONHARD KAUPISCH

[speaking in German] *It will take days to dominate Europe!*

ADOLF HITLER

[speaking in German] *We've already signed the Tripartite Pact with Italy and Japan to conquer the world, and we must do to the same. That includes France where we lost the battle to the Allies years ago.*

HANS GRAF VON SPONECK

[speaking in German] *You fought the Western Front in the Great War?*

ADOLF HITLER

[speaking in German] *I was a soldier on the Western Front years ago when I saw both sides playing games with our own on Christmas Day, but I'm the only one who despised those foolish games.*

CUT TO:

INT. WESTERN FRONT, GERMAN TRENCH - DAY (FLASHBACK)

SUPER: "WESTERN FRONT, CHRISTMAS 1914."

After witnessing the football game on the trench, Hitler calls the German HQ on the phone.

ADOLF HITLER [V.O.] (CONT'D)

[continue in German] *I decided to call the German HQ that the Allies are playing the football on the trench with my fellow soldiers, and everyone got their Christmas presents except me. I got coal for Christmas and think that I'm a naughty boy, but I'm not, because I'm the only soldier who follows orders!*

BACK TO SCENE

ADOLF HITLER (CONT'D)

[continue in German] *After the Christmas Truce, we got back into the fight against the Allies on the Western Front and that is why I want you to take revenge on the Allies for giving me some coal for Christmas and our defeat on the Western Front.*

LEONHARD KAUPISCH

[speaking in German] *Ah, yes. The English and the French. Now we know where France is.*

ADOLF HITLER

[shouting in German] *Then get out there and start conquering Europe!*

The German Generals give the Nazi salute to the Fuhrer and left the office to dominate the Allies in Europe.

DISSOLVE TO:

TITLE: "WORLD WAR II: THE ANIMATED SERIES."

CUT TO:

EPISODE TITLE: "BLITZKRIEG."

GO TO:

INT. SS-JUNKERS SCHOOL - DAY

SUPER: "BAD TOLZ, GERMANY. ONE YEAR LATER."

It was a beautiful spring of 1940. THE NAZI CADETS are at the SS-Junkers School to prepare for their domination in Europe. Siegfried von Zachmann is one of the Nazi Cadets who participate for Waffen SS training.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

I can't believe we've lost the war to the Allies years ago at France.

AREND

Yeah, I can't believe it either. The Allies overpowered us on the Western Front.

BERTHOLD

At least we've won the Eastern Front in the last war before Czar Nicholas II was executed along with his family at Russia.

SIEGBERT

And taking control of Poland on the west was a good start, but the problem is the Soviet Union took control the other half of Poland on the east.

HEINRICH

Not just Poland, but both Austria and Czechoslovakia are under our control too.

Then, Fedor von Bock enters the classroom.

FEDOR VON BOCK

Good morning, gentlemen.

(MORE)

FEDOR VON BOCK (CONT'D)

I am Commander General Fedor von Bock and welcome to SS-Junkers School. My Fuhrer sent me to teach you how to train to become the Waffen SS.

CLAUS

[raising his hand] Commander, what is SS stands for?

FEDOR VON BOCK

SS stands for *Schutzstaffel* and speaking of which, we have just learned the British have returned to France and I expect the Allies will do the same tactics and strategies against us, just like they did to us in the Great War and it's up to you cadets to start your training to overpower our enemies and conquer Europe starting with your basic combat training. First, you will start your exercise training. Then, you will use the parachute training. Next, you will do some target practice with your rifles. Finally, you will practice with your submachine gun. Now get out there and start your basic combat training.

EXT. SS-JUNKERS SCHOOL - TRAINING FIELD - DAY

The German Cadets are waiting for their orders from General von Bock at the training field.

FEDOR VON BOCK (CONT'D)

Alright, gentlemen, your first training begins now, and you will be going the obstacle course. First, you will walk over these tires.

(MORE)

FEDOR VON BOCK (CONT'D)

Next, you will climb up the wall and go to the other side. Then, you will each take turns swinging on these ropes, landing on the mat. Fourth, you will go on top of the balancing bridge and quickly balance walk your way. Finally, you will crawl through the tunnel and make your way to the flag goal. Got it?

GERMAN CADETS

Jawohl!

FEDOR VON BOCK

Then start running now!

The German Cadets follow orders to start the obstacle course. They walked over the tires, climbing up the wall and went to the other side of the wall. They took turns by swinging on the ropes to land on the mat safely. One-by-one, most of the German Cadets are walking on the balancing bridge, but some of them fall off the balancing bridge and they must start on the balancing bridge again. They went through the tunnel until Siegfried made it to the flag goal first.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

I got it first!

FEDOR VON BOCK

Good job, Siegfried! You passed your first test! Now we will go to a new one.

The German Cadets are preparing for their next training mission: the parachute jump training.

FEDOR VON BOCK (CONT'D)

Gentlemen, your next lesson will be the parachute jump training.

EXT. GERMAN AIRFIELD - DAY

FEDOR VON BOCK (CONT'D)

You will use your parachutes to prevent you falling from death. In this training session, your drop zone from parachute jump will be 900 feet.

The Junkers Ju-52 tri-motored transport plane lands on the airfield. TWO GERMAN PILOTS exit the transport plane to meet the German Cadets and Fedor von Bock.

WOLFGANG

Herr, are these your cadets you're training for our upcoming invasion?

FEDOR VON BOCK

Gentlemen, I want you to meet Wolfgang and his co-pilot, Kurt.

KURT

Welcome to our parachute training, Siegfried.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

(gives a handshake to Kurt) It's good to see you two.

WOLFGANG

We've just received the message from the *Fuhrer* that the British arrived at France again.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Why France? We've already lost the war to the Allies before we take Paris.

KURT

Then it's your chance to redeem yourself in France. Hopefully, we'll turn things around.

FEDOR VON BOCK

Achtung! Enough with the past! I need you guys to stay focused and concentrate on your second test. Cadets, I need 18 volunteers to practice for a parachute jump.

HEINDRICH

I'll go first.

CLAUS

I'll go next.

AREND

I'll go afterwards.

FEDOR VON BOCK

Then this means Siegfried will practice parachute jumping after Berthold. The rest of you will stay here until their parachute training is completed. Kurt, get everyone onboard the transport. It's time for the cadets to begin parachute training.

KURT

Jawohl. Everyone, follow me.

18 German Cadets follow Kurt and Wolfgang to the tri-motor transport plane. They watch as the Ju-52 takes off from the airfield.

INT./EXT. JUNKERS JU-52 - CONTINUOUS

WOLFGANG

Alright, guys, listen up and listen well. Each of you will jump at low altitude for your training. Heindrich, you're up first.

Heindrich stands up to follow Wolfgang's instructions.

WOLFGANG (CONT'D)

Action Station! Stand at the door!

HEINDRICH

I'm ready, Wolfgang!

WOLFGANG

Jump!

Heindrich jumps out of the plane and pulls the ripcord from his parachute.

EXT. GERMAN AIRFIELD - DAY

He lands on the ground with his feet.

HEINDRICH

How did I do?

FEDOR VON BOCK

You didn't do well, Heindrich.
Your feet shouldn't be touching on
the ground! You could've broken
your legs! Now get back in line
and try again!

INT./EXT. JUNKERS JU-52 - CONTINUOUS

Now it's Claus's turn to practice his parachute jump at 900 feet.

WOLFGANG

Jump!

Claus jumps out of the plane at 900 feet. He struggles to find the ripcord from his parachute. He pulls the ripcord just in time. He lands on the ground safely.

CLAUS

Herr von Bock, I couldn't find the
ripcord on my parachute.

FEDOR VON BOCK

Claus, the ripcord is on the back
of the parachute. Don't hesitate
while trying to find the ripcord
on your parachute. Get back in
line and repeat the training
mission.

Wolfgang gives the signal to Arend as he prepares for his jump at 900 feet.

WOLFGANG

Jump!

Arend jumps out of the plane, but he neglects opening his parachute, then on the last second, he opens his parachute before hitting on the ground. Commander von Bock scolds severely at Cadet Arend.

FEDOR VON BOCK

Arend, why didn't you open your parachute?

AREND

Because I must wait until I reach 100 feet above the ground.

FEDOR VON BOCK

That is no excuse for jumping 100 feet! Now, get back in line and try again! Get back in line!

AREND

Back in line, sir?

FEDOR VON BOCK

[whispering] *Ja*, back in line!

After all the German Cadets completing their parachute jump training, Siegfried is the last German Cadet to make a successful parachute jump in 900 feet.

WOLFGANG

Get ready Siegfried! This is your only chance!

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

You know I'm afraid of heights!

WOLFGANG

Now!

Siegfried jumps off the plane! He was scared, and he's about to die in 900 feet! In the nick of time, Siegfried pulls the ripcord on his parachute. No longer scared, he safely lands on the ground. Commander von Bock was pleased.

FEDOR VON BOCK

Very good, Siegfried! You successfully jumped at 900 feet. You've conquered your fear, and now it's time for a new one.

EXT. GRAFENWOEHR TRAINING AREA

The German Cadets are preparing for their next training at Grafenwoehr Training Area. This time, it was the firearm training.

FEDOR VON BOCK (CONT'D)

Your next training is to use your rifle. You must take a shot and hit many rounds as possible before running out of your ammo. Cadets, grab your rifles.

The German Cadets grabbed their rifles to prepare for their target practice. Commander von Bock must step away before the German Cadets can fire at their target.

FEDOR VON BOCK (CONT'D)

Cadets, you may fire when ready.

The German Cadets open fire at their targets with their rifles. Commander von Bock looks over the German Cadets whether they're doing well or not. He looks at Berthold.

FEDOR VON BOCK (CONT'D)

How's it going, Berthold?

BERTHOLD

It's much easier than we did in the last war.

FEDOR VON BOCK

Well, let's hope our victory makes us easier than losing the war to the Allies.

Commander von Bock looks at Heindrich. He's having a hard time loading the bullets on his rifle.

HEINDRICH

I don't know how to load my rifle!

FEDOR VON BOCK

Use your bullets Heindrich, and make sure you reload your rifle before continuing your training.

HEINDRICH

Jawohl.

Arend fires at the target until his rifle is jammed.

AREND

Sir! My weapon is jammed!

FEDOR VON BOCK

Then unjam your weapon, Arend. It's an easier way to get your rifle ready.

Commander von Bock looks at Claus. He misses his target.

FEDOR VON BOCK

Claus!

CLAUS

Ja?

FEDOR VON BOCK

Why aren't you aiming at the target?

CLAUS

Because I can't hit the target with the rifle!

FEDOR VON BOCK

It doesn't matter which weapon you're using! Just focus on the target!

CLAUS

Jawohl!

Siegbert fires at the target faster than Siegfried's.

FEDOR VON BOCK

Good shooting, Siegbert. You hit the target perfectly. You're promoted to *Oberschütze*.

SIEGBERT

Danke, sir!

FEDOR VON BOCK

And Siegfried, you tried very hard for a target practice. Your position will be a rank of *Soldat*.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Me? I'm *Soldat* rank?

FEDOR VON BOCK

Ja, you will get another chance to redeem yourself.

The German Cadets are preparing for their new weapon of war to practice for building infiltration.

FEDOR VON BOCK

Herren, this is MP40 submachine gun. It was a successor to the MP35 submachine gun and fired 32 rounds to take down the Allied soldiers. Remember, it takes 500-550 rounds per minute to kill the enemies. Your stick grenade is required to deal more damage by knocking down enemy defenses. Once the enemy defenses are down, you will then proceed inside the building and engage the enemy in close quarters and provide cover for advancing soldiers.

(MORE)

FEDER VON BOCK (CONT'D)

This will cause the enemy defenders to create panic or disorganized. Once you've reached the top, you must raise the flag to secure the building. Siegfried, you and the other five cadets will assign as *Gustav* Group. GROUP *ANTON*, you're up first.

The German Cadets of Group *Anton* infiltrate the building first. One of the German Cadets throws a grenade inside the building and explodes. They fire at the stationary targets. They climb up until they reach the top of the building.

FEDER VON BOCK (CONT'D)

Well done, Group *Anton*. You can come down now.

Group *Anton* exit the building.

FEDER VON BOCK (CONT'D)

GROUP *BERTA*, you're up!

Group *Berta* infiltrate the building, but ONE OF THE GERMAN CADETS drops the grenade inside the window and explodes. They fire at the stationary targets. They climb up to the top of the building. Commander von Bock speaks severely to one of the German Cadets of Group *Berta*.

FEDER VON BOCK (CONT'D)

Frank, you know to rules of Waffen SS training! You need to throw a grenade inside the building, not dropping it! You could get yourself killed, especially for your upcoming invasion! GROUP *CESAR*, you're next.

Frank and other four German Cadets of Group *Berta* exit the building as Group *Cesar* begin their infiltration on the building, one of the German Cadets throw the grenade inside the building. They fire at the stationary targets, except ONE OF THE GERMAN CADETS OF GROUP *CESAR* forgot to reload his MP40 machine gun. They all went up to the top of the building. Commander von Bock speaks to one of the German Cadets of Group *Cesar*.

FEDER VON BOCK (CONT'D)

Ludwig, why is your machine gun not loaded?

LUDWIG

Because I thought we finished our training.

FEDER VON BOCK

Next time, make sure you reload your machine gun before you begin your training. Next GROUP.

The next group is Group *Dora*. Commander von Bock gives a signal to Group *Dora*. The German Cadets infiltrate the building, but one of the German Cadets throws the grenade at the window. After the German Cadets fire at the stationary targets, ONE OF THE GERMAN CADETS OF GROUP *DORA* went inside the building first before other German Cadets reach the top of the building. Commander von Bock wasn't happy about leaving his group behind.

FEDER VON BOCK (CONT'D)

Ludolf, where's your group?

LUDOLF

Which group?

FEDER VON BOCK

You're the Group *Dora*! Why did you leave your group behind?

LUDOLF

Because I want to reach the top first.

FEDER VON BOCK

You should never leave your group behind, especially on the battlefield! Go back, regroup, and start all over again!

After the other two groups completed their infiltration training, Siegfried and his group are preparing for their infiltration training.

FEDER VON BOCK (CONT'D)

Group *Gustav*, you're the last group for the infiltration training. Load your weapons.

They load their weapons to prepare for their infiltration training.

SIEGBERT

We're ready, sir!

FEDER VON BOCK

Then proceed to the building.

SIEGBERT

This is it, *Jungen!* We need to work together as a team. Arend, you throw the grenade at the building. Heindrich, you, Berthold, and Claus take out the targets on the left. Siegfried and I will deal with the targets on the right.

Arend throws the grenade at the window and explodes.

SIEGBERT (CONT'D)

Let's go, *Jungen!*

Siegbert and Group *Gustav* proceed to the building. Siegbert kicks the door, allowing Siegfried and five German Cadets infiltrate the building. Arend follows Siegfried and Siegbert to the right, while Heindrich, Claus, and Berthold went to the left side to knock out the targets with their submachine gun blazing. Finally, they regrouped and went upstairs to the top of the building. Commander von Bock came to see Siegfried and his group.

FEDER VON BOCK

Congratulations, Group *Gustav!* You've completed all the training missions! You and your group surpassed Group *Anton*, and Siegfried, you are promoted to *Schütze*.

(MORE)

FEDER VON BOCK (CONT'D)

Arend, for being an expert on explosives, you are promoted to Grenadier. You can all go back to your camps now.

INT. WAFFEN SS BOOT CAMP - NIGHT

That night, the German Cadets are at the Waffen SS Boot Camp and talk about the upcoming invasion of low countries and France.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

So, are you saying that we're going to redeem ourselves in the Western Front?

SIEGBERT

Ja, we've lost the war against the Allies years ago, and now the Fuhrer wants us to get revenge for our loss in the last war.

AREND

And not only that, but the Treaty of Versailles was also signed between us and the Allies one year after the war.

HEINDRICH

Yeah, before the Nazis were established, the Allies grow stronger on the Western Front, but now it's our chance to give the Allies what they deserved.

CLAUS

Like what?

HEINDRICH

By using more firepower to take down the Allies on the Western Front and pay our enemies an ultimate price with our new weapons and new war machines.

BERTHOLD

Like the panzers and the
Luftwaffe?

HEINDRICH

Of course we have, Berthold. Our
Luftwaffe squadron includes
Messerschmitt Fighters, Stuka
Dive-Bombers, and twin-engine
bombers.

CLAUS

Don't forget, we have new armored
cars and new machine guns to take
down the Allies by force.

AREND

That includes self-propelled
artillery, new howitzers, and
half-tracks.

SIEGBERT

But still, we have the artillery
pieces and flamethrowers to knock
out the Allied defenses to take
Paris, but we must not fail this
time.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Since the Great War?

SIEGBERT

Exactly. We must prevail before
the Allies use their same tactics
in the Western Front years ago.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Then we will correct the mistakes
that we made in the Western Front
and find the alternative path to
take Paris, but the problem is,
the enemy have anti-tank guns and
artillery to fortify their
defenses.

HEINDRICH

And worse, they have anti-aircraft guns to disrupt our air support.

SIEGBERT

Don't be silly, Heindrich! The Allies couldn't use their anti-aircraft guns because they're not accurate enough to bring our planes down.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Alright, that's enough! Let's get some sleep. We have a deadline for next month.

SIEGBERT

Alright, we'll see you in the morning.

AREND

You'll be good at invasion of Western Front, Siegfried.

BERTHOLD

Yeah, we'll promise to take control of France and the low countries.

EXT. GERMAN AIRFIELD - DAY

SUPER: ONE MONTH LATER. MAY 10, 1940.

The Nazi Waffen SS are getting ready for their invasion of France and the low countries where they fought in the Great War against the Allies, and now it's time for Siegfried and the Waffen SS to get a chance to redeem themselves to take Paris. They all board the Junkers 52 tri-motor transport planes.

INT. JUNKERS JU 52 - DAY

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

I've been waiting for this moment, Siegbert. Paris will be ours, and we will make sure our enemy give what they deserve.

HEINDRICH

I couldn't agree more, Siegfried!
Once we reach our target, we will
lay waste on the Allies and make
them pay for what they did to us
in the last war.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

You mean the Great War that we've
lost?

CLAUS

That's right, Siegfried! They beat
us on the Western Front, and now
it's a perfect time for us to take
over Paris and the low countries.

AREND

That includes Holland and Belgium.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

What about Denmark and Norway?

BERTHOLD

Denmark is already under our
control and there's ongoing war on
Norway.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

So, what are we doing now?

SIEGBERT

We split up on our mission on the
Western Front. Since Luxembourg is
already invaded, Groups C & D
Companies are going to attack
Holland. Groups E & F Companies
are going to invade Belgium again,
and the rest of us are going to
take France with our new weapons.

WOLFGANG

(on radio) Is everyone ready?

KURT

(on radio in German) *Ja.*

WOLFGANG

(on radio) Then prepare for
takeoff.

EXT. JUNKERS JU 52 - CONTINUOUS

The Ju-52s are preparing for takeoff on the runway. The
transport planes fly one-by-one until they fly in formation.

INT. JUNKERS JU 52 - CONTINUOUS

Inside the Ju 52, Siegfried is worried about going off-course.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

I was afraid of this, Siegbert.
It's going to be like the Great
War all over again.

SIEGBERT

Don't be afraid, Siegfried,
everything's going to be fine.

HEINDRICH

What if our plan goes wrong?

SIEGBERT

Then our *Blitzkrieg* will be short-
lived.

CLAUS

Blitzkrieg? You mean the
"lightning war?"

SIEGBERT

That's right, Claus. Once we reach
our destination, it's our chance
to jump about 150 meters.

AREND

150 meters? For real?

SIEGBERT

Ja, our Panzer Division are waiting for us to take control of France again.

BERTHOLD

We took Belgium once, and we can do it again.

HEINDRICH

And this time, Holland is going down, along with Norway.

SIEGBERT

Then it's time to jump 150 meters in low countries and France.

ONE OF THE WEHRMACHT calls out to the German Soldiers.

GERMAN SOLDIER #1

Steh Auf!

They all stand up.

GERMAN SOLDIER #1 [CONT'D]

Verbindet Sich!

The hooks are strapped in as they hear the Allied flaks burst all around them.

GERMAN SOLDIER #1 [CONT'D]

Stehen an den Turen!

One of the Wehrmacht stands at the door.

GERMAN SOLDIER #1 [CONT'D]

Springen!

All the Waffen SS jump at 150 meters. All the parachutes are open. As each German Paratroopers descend, some of the Germans get caught in the trees while others land safely on the ground.

EXT. ARDENNE, FRANCE - DAY

The Gustav Group are at the starting position at Ardenne, France. The Waffen SS load their weapons to get ready to start their *Blitzkrieg* attack.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Where are we?

SIEGBERT

We're at Ardenne.

AREND

It's where the Allies fought the Western Front in the last war and won.

CLAUS

Then this will be perfect revenge for defeating us in the Great War and we're going to take Paris just as our Fuhrer's planned.

BERTHOLD

I agree with you. The Fuhrer wants to dominate Europe. Once we take Paris, and when we do, then we'll be ready to conquer Britain.

HEINDRICH

How do we get to Paris? The British are aiding France again.

SIEGBERT

But we're not alone. We made an alliance with Italy.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

I thought the Italians are on their side.

SIEGBERT

Nein, the Italians made an alliance with us this time. They're attacking France on the Alps...

(MORE)

SIEGBERT [CONT'D]

...but we're going take Ardennes first, then we'll take Sedan if we have a chance. Once we take control of Sedan, we will cross the Meuse River and attack Arras.

AREND

How can we take the Maginot Line?

SIEGBERT

Simple. We're going to use the Manstein Plan to invade low countries and France.

BERTHOLD

So, are we Army Group A?

SIEGBERT

Ja, we're going to take Sedan. Army Group B is going to take Abbeville and Army Group C will take the Maginot Line.

HEINDRICH

Then let's correct the mistakes and start our *Blitzkrieg*.

SIEGBERT

All right then, let's move!

The German Army Group A prepare for their assault on Sedan.

EXT. SEDAN, FRANCE - DAY

SUPER: MAY 12, 1940.

SFX: ARTILLERY BOMBARDMENT SOUND

As the Germans use the rubber boats to cross the Meuse River, the French open fire at the Army Group A, but only 15 rubber boats successfully cross the Meuse River.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Did everyone make it?

SIEGBERT

Not everyone. Only 15 rubber boats
made it out.

Arend looked through the binoculars and saw the Allies bunker
dead ahead.

AREND

Siegbert! Look there!

Siegbert looked through the binoculars and spotted the target.

SIEGBERT

The French are using bunkers to
defend the line!

BERTHOLD

How do we get inside the bunker if
the French keep attacking us with
machine guns and artilleries?

SIEGBERT

We're going to use our air support
to clear the enemy defenses.

HEINDRICH

You mean the Luftwaffe?

SIEGBERT

Exactly! Let's call for backup.

Siegbert radios for help.

SIEGBERT [CONT'D]

(radios in German) *KESSELRING,*
this is Siegbert of Army Group A.
The enemy bunker is heavily
fortified. Requesting air support.

ALBERT KESSELRING [V.O.]

(radios in German) *Already done.*
Our squadron is on your way for
your support.

SIEGBERT

Danke. (radios in German) *Siegbert out.*

HEINDRICH

I hope this plan works.

SIEGBERT

We'll see.

SFX: STUKA SIREN SOUND

Not a moment too soon, a squadron of German Stukas dive-bombed the French bunkers so the Germans can advance. As the Luftwaffe neutralize the enemy bunker, the Germans launched their assault on the French Soldiers with flamethrowers, grenades, and machine guns. Both the French and Germans fought each other, but some of them on both sides were either killed or wounded inside the bunker before the French forced to retreat.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Sedan is taken, Siegbert.

SIEGBERT

Sehr gut, Siegfried. Claus, status report.

CLAUS

Our Panzer Divisions are split up into three groups. The 1st Panzer Division is advancing at Gauiler. The 2nd Panzer Division is advancing at Donchery and the 10th Panzer Division is advancing at Wadelincourt.

SIEGBERT

Then Gauiler will be our next objective.

Then the 1st Panzer Division shows up, along with GENERALMAJOR FRIEDRICH KIRCHNER.

FRIEDRICH KIRCHNER

Who's in charge here?

SIEGBERT

That would be me, sir. What's the situation?

FRIEDRICH KIRCHNER

Our Stukas failed to destroy the enemy bunkers.

SIEGBERT

You got to be kidding me! I thought the Luftwaffe neutralized the enemy bunkers.

FRIEDRICH KIRCHNER

And that's not even the worst part! The 10th Panzer Division failed to take Wadelincourt.

SIEGBERT

Oh toll! Not only did the Luftwaffe dive-bombing fail, but we also got an issue for the 10th Panzer Division at Wadelincourt.

HEINDRICH

Then we'll have to take Wadelincourt for ourselves.

SIEGBERT

Gute idee, Heindrich! Let's do this, double time!

The German Wehrmacht joined the 1st Panzer Division to attack Gaulier and Wadelincourt.

EXT. GAUILER, FRANCE - DAY

After successfully captured Gaulier, they built the bridge so the 1st Panzer Division can cross the bridge.

EXT. WADELINCOURT, FRANCE - DAY

The German Army Group A went for their next objective: take Wadelincourt where the 10th Panzer Division failed to cross the Meuse River.

BERTHOLD

That's where the 10th Panzer
Division attacked before we got
here!

SIEGBERT

Then we must do this for them.

SFX: AIRCRAFT APPROACHING

As they approach Wadelincourt, the German Wehrmacht spot the
enemy planes attacking the Meuse River behind them.

AREND

Enemy planes at Meuse River!

Siegbert looks behind and spots the enemy bombers attacking the
Meuse River!

SIEGBERT

Those planes aren't ours! They're
French and they're trying to stop
our advance with the help of Royal
Air Force! We need to send our
fighters to intercept them.
Siegfried, radio for Wolfram.

WOLFRAM VON RICHTHOFEN [V.O.]

(radios in German) *Hallo?*

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

(radios in German) *Wolfram, enemy
aircraft are attacking our forces
at Meuse River! You must order our
fighters to intercept enemy
planes!*

WOLFRAM VON RICHTHOFEN [V.O.]

(radios in German) *The French or
the British?*

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

(radios in German) *Both of them.*

WOLFRAM VON RICHTHOFEN [V.O.]

(radios in German) *Already done.
I'll send our fighters to stop
them.*

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Danke. (radios in German)
Siegfried out.

BERTHOLD

Did you call air support?

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Nein! The Allies are providing air
support against us!

CLAUS

Then let's hope the Allies will
give what they deserved.

Looking up at the sky, Siegfried spots a squadron of Messerschmitt Bf-109s intercepting the Allied bombers. The Allied attack fails. The Luftwaffe fighters wiped out the entire Allied bombers before they cutoff the German advance. The German Wehrmacht cheered for the Luftwaffe Fighter Squadron for saving their lives.

SIEGBERT

Achtung! There's no time to
celebrate! We've got to push
forward!

They suddenly stopped cheering.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Sorry, sir. I thought we've won.

SIEGBERT

We haven't won just yet,
Siegfried! We must take Paris, or
our history will repeat itself.

HEINDRICH

Ja, cause if we don't, then it will be like the Great War all over again.

SIEGBERT

I hope so, because Paris is the key for our world domination.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

A world domination?

SIEGBERT

Ja, once we take Paris, then Europe will be ours.

CLAUS

And after that, we'll prove that the Allies on the Western Front is wrong.

AREND

That's the other thing too Claus, signing the armistice between us and the Allies will teach them a lesson.

BERTHOLD

But Italy is already fighting in the French Alps.

SIEGBERT

I know, but we need to capture Bulson and Stonne. Once we deal with them, then we will march towards Arras.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Is this where the Allies fought against the Red Baron in the last war.

SIEGBERT

He died years ago while
dogfighting with the British
Squadron.

HEINDRICH

Alright enough of the story. Let's
get down the business, shall we?

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Ja, you're right. Siegbert, you
lead us to victory.

SIEGBERT

Alright then, follow me to Bulson.

The Waffen SS advanced towards Bulson along with the 1st Panzer
Division.

EXT. BULSON, FRANCE - DAY

As they race to Bulson, they spot the French armored vehicles to
prepare for their counterattack.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Siegbert, the French brought their
tanks!

BERTHOLD

And that's not all! They got half-
tracks and armored cars.

SIEGBERT

Kirchner, will you do the honor
and destroy the French Armored
Division?

FRIEDRICH KIRCHNER

With pleasure. *Feuer!*

The German Panzers open fire at the advancing French. The French
tanks fired back. The French suffered more casualties than the
Germans.

As the French Armored Division retreat, the Germans took out the French armored cars and half-tracks, but the French use their anti-tank guns to neutralize the German Panzers, but the Germans broke through the Allied Line and disable the French anti-tank guns by either armored piercing shells or running over them. The German Panzer Mark III's 7.92 mm MG 34 machine guns tears the French soldiers with tracer fire. The remaining French Forces retreat to Stonne.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Where are the French gone off to this time?

SIEGBERT

They're retreating to Stonne.

AREND

Then this will be our objective.

BERTHOLD

And they're trying to hold us off.

SIEGBERT

But not for long. We'll advance to Stonne and end this once and for all.

EXT. STONNE, FRANCE - CONTINUOUS

The Nazis reached their final objective at Stonne as the German 14th Infantry Division already fighting with the French Armored Division which include Char B1 and Hotchkiss H39 Tanks with self-propelled artilleries, tank destroyers, assault guns, and machine guns as the French brought reinforcements for their counterattack on the Germans. The 1st Army Division arrives just in time to see the 14th Infantry Division fighting each other.

HEINDRICH

Looks like one of our brigades are fighting with the French.

SIEGBERT

Ja, we have self-propelled artillery, assault guns, and tank destroyers to hold them off.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Thanks to our half-tracks, we don't have to worry about walking on the road all day long.

AREND

I was thinking of same thing, Siegfried. These half-tracks are transportable rather than walking on foot.

BERTHOLD

How can we advance if the French keep coming and coming?

SIEGBERT

The French are doing the same thing for what they did in the Great War, but we won't let the French get in our way.

HEINDRICH

We had better help the 14th Infantry Division before they stop our advance.

GENERAL OBERST GERD VON RUNDSTEDT leads his Army Group A to bombard the attacking French.

GERD VON RUNDSTEDT

Feuer!

The Germans open fire with self-propelled artillery killing the French attackers and disable the French armored cars, tanks, and half-tracks. The German Marder I tank destroyers take out the French B1 and Hotchkiss tanks, forcing the French to retreat. Sedan is taken. The French counterattack fails. The Germans have altered the course on the Western Front in the history of modern warfare.

SIEGBERT

The French are retreating, sir. Sedan is ours.

GERD VON RUNDTEDT

Very good, Siegbert. Now we will attack the British Army in Arras. ERWIN ROMMEL will oversee the Panzer Division to wipe them out.

SIEGBERT

Do we have enough Panzers to defeat the British at Arras?

GERD VON RUNDTEDT

We've got plenty of Panzers left. Hopefully, we can succeed unlike we did in the Great War years ago.

SIEGBERT

Then let's make the *Fuhrer* proud.

EXT. ARRAS, FRANCE - CONTINUOUS

SUPER: MAY 21, 1940.

Four days later, the British Army suffered its same fate on Arras. Unlike the Great War, the Germans crushed the British defenses with Panzers and tank destroyers along with the advancing Waffen SS. The Germans attack the British with artillery and machine guns, forcing the British to surrender. Colonel Chester Armstrong is one of them.

CHESTER ARMSTRONG

(angrily) What have you done with the French at Sedan?

SIEGBERT

You're responsible for our defeat in the last war.

CHESTER ARMSTRONG

(angrily) We defeated you once and we can do it again!

SIEGBERT

Not this time, Chester. France will fall and Paris will soon be ours.

CHESTER ARMSTRONG

France? (laughing) You'll never be going to reach Paris in time. Our soldiers are preparing for our evacuation at Dunkirk.

SIEGBERT

Dunkirk? Why did you order your soldiers to hold us off?

CHESTER ARMSTRONG

It's the key to our survival and it's our job to stop you from reaching Paris the same thing what we fought in the Great War.

SIEGBERT

But we already secure Holland and Belgium, and this will be your downfall.

CHESTER ARMSTRONG

France never falls until you and your Jerry bastards ruin our plan!

SIEGBERT

You're responsible for signing the peace treaty years ago, and thanks to our *Fuhrer*, the Treaty of Versailles is broken.

CHESTER ARMSTRONG

(growling) You dare to break the peace treaty?! Hitler is lying to you! He lays waste on Europe, killing innocent lives!

SIEGBERT

Nein, our *Fuhrer* told us the truth about you. We came here to do, and it's time for you and your Allies to pay for what you've did to us in the Western Front years ago!

CHESTER ARMSTRONG

You can't change the past,
Siegbert!

SIEGBERT

We just did! Our *Fuhrer* already
has an alternate plan for world
domination starting from Poland to
France. Once we defeat you and
your pathetic Allies here, then we
will concentrate on Britain
itself.

CHESTER ARMSTRONG

No! Not Britain! I won't let you
ruin our lives!

SIEGBERT

Oh yes, we will. Our history will
be written, and the Western Front
will be ours, but you, Chester,
are no match against our new
weapons and technologies, and
there's nothing you can do to
stand in our way.

CHESTER ARMSTRONG

Just you wait, Siegbert! Our
reinforcements will be here-

SFX: GUNSHOT SOUND

Chester was shot and slumped to the ground dying. Siegbert looks
behind Siegfried. He has a pistol in his hand.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

(breathing) Chester lied to us! He
wanted to stop us from our
advance!

SIEGBERT

He got what he deserved,
Siegfried. Now let's get going.

The Waffen SS left Chester dead on the ground as they continue for their final attack to dominate the Western Front.

EXT. DUNKIRK, FRANCE - CONTINUOUS

SUPER: MAY 26, 1940.

The Germans launch their final attack at Dunkirk where the British soldiers are evacuating.

SFX: ARTILLERY BOMBARDMENT SOUND

AREND

Siegbert! The British are getting away!

SIEGBERT

We can't let the British escape from our grasp. Berthold, call our air support!

Berthold radios for the air support to suppress the fleeing British as the German artillery continue bombarding the beaches of Dunkirk. This time it was a squadron of Messerschmitt Bf-110s attacking the retreating British on Dunkirk with bombs and cannons. Most of the British Soldiers evacuating Dunkirk while others were killed, wounded, and captured by the Germans. Heindrich saw the British Transports leaving Dunkirk!

HEINDRICH

(pointing out to the British Transports) Siegbert, they're getting away!

SIEGBERT

Don't worry, Heindrich. They won't get far.

The Germans watched the transports leaving Dunkirk. They know they're coming after the British before reaching the English Channel.

INT. COMPIEGNE WAGON - DAY

SUPER: JUNE 22, 1940.

One month later...

...the French and the Germans are preparing to sign the armistice where the peace treaty was signed in the last war. Hitler went inside the Compiegne Wagon where the Great War veteran, CHARLES HUNTZIGER is.

ADOLF HITLER

So, this is where you signed the Peace Treaty in the Great War before I came here, KEITEL.

WILHELM KEITEL

Ja, we may have lost the war in the Great War, but we did correct the mistakes that you've made.

ADOLF HITLER

I agreed with Keitel, and this time we finally gave the Allies what they deserved and took Paris from the French just as I planned.

CHARLES HUNTZIGER

How did you defeat us in the Western Front so easily?

ADOLF HITLER

We have new war machines and technologies to turn the tide on the Western Front, by using our new strategies and tactics.

CHARLES HUNTZIGER

What kind of new strategies and tactics did you use?

WILHEIM KEITEL

Simple. With our new tanks, new artillery, and new planes, we use them to outgun and outflank your soldiers at Sedan.

ADOLF HITLER

What he means is that your soldiers are poorly trained compared to Waffen SS.

CHARLES HUNTZIGER

How did we lose the war if your soldiers outnumbered us?

WILHEIM KEITEL

Your soldiers are defending their positions while our Wehrmacht are more powerful and more trainable than your Allies.

ADOLF HITLER

And you, Charles, on the other hand, your war machines are weak and out-of-date.

CHARLES HUNTZIGER

What do you mean "out-of-date?"

ADOLF HITLER

We produced Panzers, tank destroyers, artillery, mobile artillery, and planes to overrun your fortresses and bunkers.

CHARLES HUNTZIGER

D'accord, tu gagnes. We'll sign the armistice together.

French General Huntzinger signed the armistice and so did Colonel General Keitel.

EXT. ALSACE-LORRAINE MONUMENT - DAY

Hitler went outside while Siegbert and five Waffen SS visit the monument where the German Eagle impaled by the sword.

CLAUS

That's the site where we lost war to the Allies years ago.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

(reading in French) *Here on the 11th of November 1918 succumbed the criminal pride of the German Reich. Vanquished by the free peoples which it tried to enslave.*

BERTHOLD

It means the Germans has fallen to the Allies' hands.

ADOLF HITLER [V.O.]

I wouldn't say that if I were you six.

They turned to Hitler.

HEINDRICH

Adolf Hitler?

ADOLF HITLER

The past is over. It's time for us to change our future.

AREND

What future?

ADOLF HITLER

That armistice site that you guys standing in front of you is no use to me. Siegbert, put the flag to cover it.

SIEGBERT

Ja, mein Fuhrer.

SIEGFRIED VON ZACHMANN

Siegbert, don't do it! You can't change the past!

SIEGBERT

Entschuldigung Siegfried, but I must do this.

Siegbert covers the Nazi Flag to sabotage Alsace-Lorraine Monument.

SIEGBERT [CONT'D]

(calling out to Siegfried)
Siegfried, it's time to go.

Siegfried follows Siegbert's orders as he looks at the monument. Siegfried knows the Western Front will never be the same as it was before. If the Allies had won the battle against the Nazis, then the Nazis would've been defeated so easily as the German Empire did in the Great War. The Allies have turned from victory to defeat and for the first time, the Nazis took over France, along with the Western Front, but the world domination is just the beginning.
