TITLE CARD: DARKNESS EXPEDITION: THE LEGACY DOCUMENTARY - PART 1

SUBTITLE: FEATURING BRADLEY VIERA

INTERVIEWER (O.S.)

Welcome, Bradley. Let's start with some questions from the first film. How did Darkness Expedition begin?

BRADLEY

smiling slightly Well, the idea started when I was hospitalized in a psych ward. I was 14 and struggling with schizophrenia and OCD. My psychiatrist, Dr. Padilla, suggested I turn my visual hallucinations into a book, and that's where Darkness Expedition was born.

INTERVIEWER (O.S.)

That's fascinating. Can you tell us more about your psychological experiences and how they influenced your writing?

BRADLEY

Sure. I created an evil alter-ego named Brandon when I was influenced by horror movies like Insidious, The Conjuring, Sinister Circle, and Scream. Brandon would tell me to do bad things. I used to stare at myself in the bathroom mirror, talking to myself in a deep, evil voice while pushing my stomach to look rough. It eventually caused hallucinations.

That's intense. How did you manage these hallucinations and turn them into a creative outlet?

BRADLEY

I was hospitalized multiple times, but I took advantage of my thoughts by writing them down. Initially, it was for a book, but later it turned into a screenplay. Dr. Padilla played a huge role in guiding me through this.

INTERVIEWER (O.S.)

You mentioned horror movies influenced you. Can you elaborate on that?

BRADLEY

Absolutely. Movies like The Scream series from the '90s had a huge impact. I was particularly influenced by Ghostface, with the full black outfit. It fascinated me and became part of Brandon's persona. Watching these movies to an extreme point fed into my alterego's creation.

INTERVIEWER (O.S.)

Interesting. Let's talk about Jessie Murph. How did she inspire you?

BRADLEY

I found Jessie Murph on TikTok. One of her posts talked about losing someone to addiction, which resonated with me. Her song "What Happened to Ryan" and its music video inspired the real-life/fictional storyline for Ryan and Jessie in the film. Her music often deals with female rage and pain, which I incorporated into the characters' struggles.

INTERVIEWER (O.S.)

How did you incorporate these themes into the first film?

BRADLEY

In the first two scenes, I depicted Ryan struggling with alcohol addiction, inspired by Jessie's music. Her experiences and emotions deeply influenced the characters' journeys, especially in portraying the psychological and physical pain they endure.

INTERVIEWER (O.S.)

Thank you for sharing that, Bradley. It's incredible how you've turned your challenges into such a powerful creative force. Let's take a break and continue with more questions after this.

INTERVIEWER (O.S.)

Welcome back, Bradley. Let's dive deeper into the making of *Darkness Expedition*. How did you develop the characters and the storyline?

BRADLEY

What message do you hope viewers take away from Darkness Expedition?

BRADLEY

I hope viewers understand the importance of confronting their inner demons and the power of redemption. I want them to see that even in the darkest times, there's a way to find light and purpose. Mental health struggles are real, but they don't have to define you.

BRADLEY

(nods)

I agree. The future is uncertain, but it's nice to have a strong connection and see where it might lead. For now, I'm just happy to have the opportunity to work with Jessie and share this experience.

INTERVIEWER (O.S.)

Thank you both for sharing your thoughts and insights. It's been wonderful to hear about your connection and how it has evolved through this project.
