A loud, deafening sound, filled the room. Instantly, everything turned dark.

CUT TO

SC 4 INT. HOSPITAL - MORNING

The bride opens her eyes, slowly. She can see a nurse standing next to her bed.

NURSE
(friendly)
Good morning. I will call the
doctor.

The nurse leaves the room. The bride who has head injured, try to look around. She sees a man lying on different bed, next to her. She tries to remember what happened.

CUT TO

FRIEND

CUT TO

SC 6 INT. CITY HALL - AFTERNOON

Few Months after the tragic event, the bride attends a community meeting at city hall. This community is a community of war victims. One of the speakers is a priest, who also war victim. The priest must lost his right foot after one of the fighter jets dropped the bomb, near the church.

The bride is listening the priest and also testimonial from one of the community members. One of the members, name Sebastian gives testimonial.

SEBASTIAN

(sad)
