## Logline

## **Synopsis**

Each piece on the board represents someone from his past, a family member, a colleague, a friend. With every move, Michael must choose who advances, who falls... and who pays the ultimate price. As the psychological and moral pressure intensifies, the line between strategy and conscience begins to blur.

Trapped in a game where his past misdeeds are weaponized against him, Michael faces an impossible dilemma: preserve his own life or confront the truth he's spent years burying.

"The Move" is a tense, character-driven psychological thriller exploring power, guilt, and the quiet horror of accountability, where the most dangerous opponent isn't across the board, but buried deep within.
