She blessed her food and started to eat.

MOM Nothing really. Since your dad...

She stopped what she was about to say. Started to feel emotional she took a deep breath before she finished.

MOM (CONT'D) Well, I don't have to clean up as much, so just what you see me doing now.

ALEXANDRA I thought you were taking trips? Wow, all day? It must be nice.
