ALEX 1

Yes, and you know this because you make me tell you all the time. Now cane we please go to sleep? I've got a huge day tomorrow.

KATIE

Or we could stay up all night watching movies and forget about work.

He gives her a "are you serious look"

KATIE (CONT'D)

fine, but this weekend we need to do something big. We need to celebrate

ALEX 1

You got it!

He kisses her on the forehead and sets the picture on the dresser behind her, the camera lingers on the picture, the camera racks out of focus.

INT. BEDROOM - MORNING

The camera comes back into focus, light seeps into the room, morning has come. The picture on the nightstand has changed the subjects are the same but the background has seemingly been replaced.

KATIE reaches over to find the bed empty. She exits the bed and goes to the closet. She sifts through the clothes a puzzled look on her face. Finally pulling out an outfit.

INT. KITCHEN - MORNING

ALEX stands at the counter dressed for work pouring coffee into a thermos. She approaches from behind and kisses him on the cheek.

Morning.

KATIE

Hey, do you know where all my clothes are a bunch of them are missing or something?

ALEX 2

No Idea.

KATIE

Well there's also a bunch of stuff in there I don't recognize.

ALEX 2

Doing too much shopping?

KATIE

No. I'm telling you it's like the whole closet's been replaced.

ALEX 2

Look, I don't know anything about your wardrobe. None of my business.

KATIE is stunned by ALEX's tone and changes the conversation.

KATIE

So what are we doing this weekend?

ALEX 2

I have to work.

KATIE

But last night...

He cuts her off.

ALEX 2

Last night I told you I have to work all weekend.

KATIE

I thought.

ALEX 2

Well maybe there's the problem

KATIE

What did you say to me?

What Katie? what did I say this time?

KATIE stands in a stunned silence ALEX grabs his coffee and walks off.

INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

KATIE sits next to ALEX who is scrolling through his phone.

KATIE

Babe?

ALEX 2

What?

KATIE

Can you please talk to me instead of looking at your phone?

Alex puts his phone down.

ALEX 2

What?

KATIE

Can we talk about this morning?

ALEX 2

What's there to talk about?

KATIE

Last night you told me we could go out this weekend and celebrate and this morning you were talking to me like I was crazy.

ALEX 2

I never said that. You know I'm swamped at work.

KATIE

Why are you doing this?

ALEX 2

I'm not doing anything Katie you're the one making stuff up.

KATIE

Maybe we don't need to talk. Not until you stop acting like a jackass.

I don't know what your problem is lately.

KATIE

My problem?

ALEX 2

Yeah you're acting like a total bitch

KATIE

Don't you dare talk to me like that.

ALEX 2

Or what?

KATIE

Out!

ALEX 2

What?

KATIE

Out! Go sleep at a hotel or something I don't care I just can't look at you right now.

Alex grabs his phone and storms off the camera racks out of focus and the picture shifts back to original look.

INT. BEDROOM - MORNING

KATIE wakes up in her bed. ALEX 1 kisses her on the forehead.

KATIE

What are you doing?

ALEX 1

Saying good morning? What else should I be doing?

An awkward silence fills the air.

ALEX 1

So this weekend, I was thinking...

KATIE

(INTERRUPTING)

I thought you had to work?

ALEX 1

Huh?

KATIE

You told me yesterday you had to work all weekend, So go.

ALEX 1

I never work weekends. What are you talking about?

KATIE

Why do you keep acting like this?

ALEX 1

Like what?

KATIE

Like I have no idea what I'm talking about.

ALEX 1

You're the one that's trying to kick me out.

KATIE

Alex, please.

ALEX 1

Fine, you want me to go I'll go.

ALEX 1 walks out of the door.

INT. BEDROOM - LATER

KATIE lays on the bed holding the picture of her and ALEX 1, her face red, tears dripping across her cheeks, she blinks, her eyes becoming heavy. The picture falls out of her hand and on to the bed.

The camera racks out of focus, the picture warping again.

INT. BEDROOM - LATER

KATIE awakens in a daze. She picks the picture up from the bed a puzzled look on her face.

INT. KITCHEN

KATIE stands at the counter the picture in front of her. Her phone rings. It's ALEX, she answers but doesn't say anything.

ALEX 2 (V.O)

You there?

KATIE

Yeah. Are you ready to start acting like yourself again?

ALEX 2 (V.O)

Excuse me?

KATIE

You've been acting crazy for days.

ALEX 2 (V.O)

What do you mean?

KATIE

You know what I mean.

ALEX 2 (V.O)

Look I'm coming home I'll talk to you soon.

ALEX hangs up the phone.

KATIE pulls the phone away from her face and looks at the phone and then back to the picture.

INT. LIVING ROOM - LATER

ALEX 2 opens the door. KATIE rushes towards him

KATIE

Alex!

ALEX 2

What?

KATIE

Did you do something with the picture upstairs?

ALEX 2

What picture?

KATIE

The one from our trip last spring.

ALEX 2

We didn't take any trip.

KATIE

No, the one where we went and I met your friend Mike.

ALEX 2

Who's Mike?

ALEX pushes past KATIE and goes to the fridge and pulls out a bottle and pours a drink KATIE follows after him.

KATIE

Your, Your best friend from college.

ALEX 2

ALEX 2

I don't know anyone named Mike!

KATIE loses the last bit of composure she has left and she screams at ALEX.

KATIE

INT. LIVING ROOM - LATER

ALEX is in the living room tape and moving boxes are spread around the space.

KATIE

Alex!

ALEX 1

Good, you're up we need to talk.

KATIE

You're right. We do.

ALEX 1

It's hard to live with you lately, kicking me out one minute, loving on me like you haven't seen me in weeks the next. It's like being engaged to two different people. It's too much.

KATIE
